# YMCA of Indiana County Policies

Thank you for visiting the YMCA of Indiana County through the Membership Reciprocity Program. We want you to stay active and keeping moving so we have no made sure there is a Y wherever you are and we are happy to have you visit us.

We want to make you familiar with our local policies and procedures. We are committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members and guests. We expect all those using our Y to behave in a mature and responsible way and to respect the rights and dignity of other. Our Code of Conduct does not permit language or any action that can hurt or frighten another person or that falls below a generally accepted start of conduct; specifically:

- Inappropriate attire including offensive working on shirt/accessories
- Any or vulgar language including swearing, name-calling or shouting
- Physical contact with another person in an angry or threatening way
- Any demonstration of sexual contact or activity
- Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language or any other menacing behavior
- Theft or behavior with results in the destruction of property
- Using or possessing illegal chemicals or alcohol in/on YMCA property
- Any other conduct of inappropriate, threatening or offensive natures
- Loitering is not permitted inside or outside the YMCA

Members, reciprocal members and guests are encouraged to politely inform any person whose behavior threatens their safety or comfort. YMCA staff members are always available to assist if the matter is not resolved. When a violation of the code of conduct has occurred the decision to suspend or terminate YMCA membership privileges will be made by YMCA management. YMCA management will immediately contact the home YMCA.

Schedules of our programs and areas are available on our mobile app (available by searching YMCA of Indiana County in the app store) and our website, [www.icymca.org](http://www.icymca.org)

Reciprocal members wishing to register for a program may do so at the non-member rate.

Reciprocal members may use all areas of our facility – including the pool, gymnasium and fitness center.

- Children over the age of 6 must use gender-specific locker rooms. Our family changing room is available for parents and children of opposite genders.
- Children 7 & under must be accompanied by an adult at all times (unless in a supervised program).
- Children ages 8-10 must have an adult in the building at all times (unless in a program or rec room).
- Youth 11-17 are allowed to enter the building without an adult and participate in the following:
- Members ages 8 through 11 must complete Fitness Center orientation and have parental supervision to enter the fitness center and use cardio equipment only (blue band).
- Members ages 12 through 14 who complete the Fitness Center Orientation may use the cardio equipment on their own.
- Members ages 12 through 14 who have passed the Fitness Center Strength Training Certification may use the cardio or Cybex equipment on their own but must have direct parental supervision to be in the free weight area (red band).
- Members ages 15 and up should complete a Fitness Center orientation or the appropriate paperwork at the Welcome Center prior to using the Fitness Center.
