- Hire, schedule and train all Child Watch staff with the assistance of the Director of Youth and Family Programs.
- Dress appropriately for duty.
- Supervise and engage participants
- Maintain a clean and safe area
- Maintain care of equipment
- Maintain a professional appearance by wearing appropriate dress(Y shirt and khaki or black pants) and a Y name tag.
- Concentrate on children in your care and do not let other things (cell phone, homework, friends, etc) distract you from the task at hand.
- Other related duties as assigned.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to stand for the duration of the shift
- Must be able to bend and stoop occasionally
- Must be able to lift 35 pounds occasionally
- Must be able to stay in the pool for an extended period of time
