The Big Hearts, Little Hands Mentoring Program is a program offered by the YMCA of Indiana County. The program connects children with adults who positively influence them. The program's Bigs connect with their Littles once a week to spend time and have fun with them, as well as to encourage them to make good choices throughout the week. The positive connection has a great impact on our Little's lives.

LITTLES

Any child that is between the age of 6-17, resides in Indiana County, and expresses the desire to be in the program is eligible to become a little. Their enrollment will consist of an interest form and attending monthly mentoring meetings. Littles will receive the following:

- Free membership to the YMCA of Indiana County and Mack Park Pool for as long as they are active participants of BHLH.
- Free program participation! Includes swim lessons, soccer, basketball and more!
- Free monthly activities, including family events, BHLH specific events, and group mentoring.
